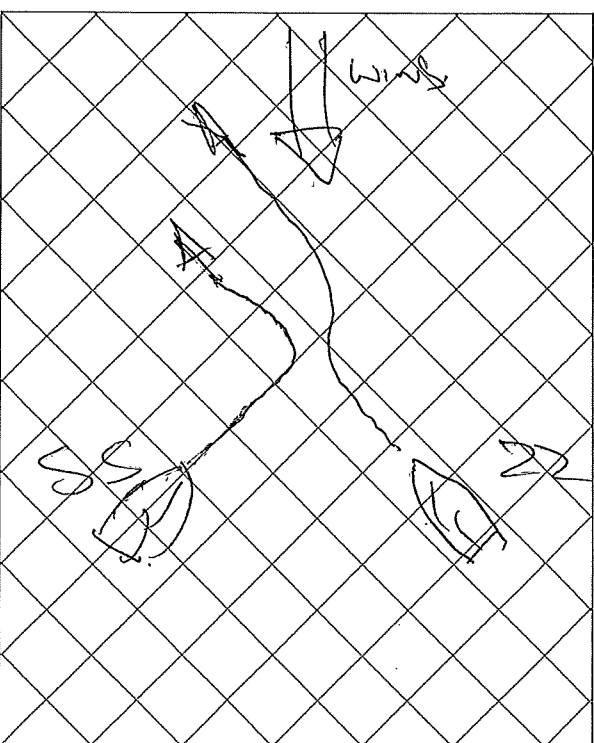

- 2. Saucy Sausage tacked, coming to a close hauled course 2m below and abeam of Zig Zag.
- 3. There was no collision.
